

Captain Audition Requirements

- Tuesday, March 9th 4:45pm
- Have at least 2 year experience on the team.(Discretion of Directors)
- Complete an interview on audition day.
- Members will be expected to clean and instruct a group of line members using the current years tryout routine.
- Be prepared to run through roughly 16 counts, directors discretion. You will be watched as to how well you can keep rehearsals going in the absence of your instructor.

Feature Twirler Audition Requirements

- To take place the same day as Majorette Auditions.
- **Mary G. Montgomery High School Marching Band reserves the right to select no Feature Twirler if it deems no audition met required standards.**
- Have at least 1 year experience on the majorette line.
- Complete an interview on audition day.
- Vertical 3 turn
- Horizontal 3 turn
- High Toss Illusion
- Two Baton
- Three Baton
- Splits, Leaps, and Kicks
- Flexibility, and Showmanship.
- The applicant will perform a two minute routine to music of their choice showcasing the above requirements.
- In any given year, the MGM Marching Band reserves the right to select no feature twirler if no applicant is deemed qualified to serve as feature twirler of the MGM Marching Band.
- Feature Twirler auditions will take place immediately after the conclusion of majorette line auditions.
- The selection of feature twirler is made by a panel of judges on the day of auditions. Directors have no input in this selection. Skill level is the main determining factor in selecting a feature twirler. Judges will also conduct an interview to determine each student's reason and desire for being MGM's next feature twirler. A point total will be awarded to each student based on her audition and interview. The student with the highest composite score will be awarded the position of feature twirler. In the event of a tie, the students' interview score will break the tie.
